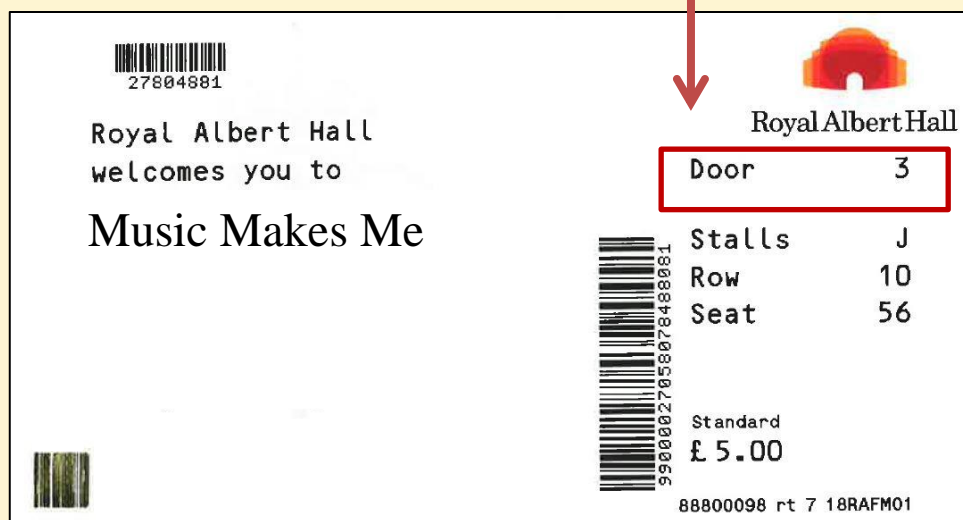

Music Makes Me takes place
at the Royal Albert Hall.
It is a music concert performed
by school children



Your ticket will have a door number on it. This is the same number as the door you will go through to enter the Hall.



There are people who work at the Hall who are there to help you. They are called stewards and they will be wearing red or grey jackets.



There are toilets in the Hall on all levels.
There are signs to show you
where the toilets are.
The Stewards can also show you.



There are cafes and bars in the Hall where you can buy food and drink. The main café is Café Bar. This is at Door 12.



When you are ready, a steward will check your ticket and show you inside the auditorium.



The concert will last 1 hour and 15 minutes.
There will not be a break during the concert.

Before the concert begins the orchestra and choir will come onto the stage.



The conductor for this concert
is called Avi Taler.



An interpreter will be on stage to provide
British Sign Language interpretation
of the concert.



During the concert, you can leave the auditorium and go to a chill-out space.



This sign will be on the chill out space doors. A steward can help you.

The concert will end, and you can clap to show the orchestra and choirs you enjoyed the performance. Other people might clap loudly.



After the show, you may want to go
to the toilet or the Café Bar.
When you are ready, a Steward can
help you leave the building.
