## **RESTRICTED ITEMS**









Animals (With the exception of certified assistance dogs)



Personal use cameras with detachable lenses of more than 6cm in length will not be allowed. Tripods and monopods are not allowed except for accredited media. Large lithium-ion batteries

Bags: one per person, needs to fit under the seat and should not exceed 25L capacity. (approx. 40cm x 30cm x 20cm)



Medicines (unless prescribed in quantity for individual personal use, commercially packaged and labeled with contents)

Selfie sticks and umbrellas over 30cm, larger umbrellas must be placed in the cloakroom.



Flags: Max size 0.5m x 1m, no flag poles, flags related to protest may be confiscated.



Bicycles and other wheeled items.

(folding and smaller items may be

suitable for storage within the

cloakroom, fees will apply)

Prams / baby carriers: These are not allowed in the seating areas but can be left in the designated buggy storage area.

Food or drink (with the exception of special dietary requirements – please make contact before the event with your requirements)



Security reserves the right to confiscate prohibited items brought onto venue. Any items confiscated will not be available for collection on exit and will be destroyed or handed to the police. Some items may be eligible to be placed in the cloakroom (Additional costs may apply). This list is subject to change.
